Please be aware that Chase Academy fees are ALL INCLUSIVE. The fee includes lunches, stationery, textbooks, and even the programme of trips during the school day. The only essential additional costs are fees for external examinations in the senior school. Each term's fees may be paid by the four equal monthly instalments shown above. For day students there is a 20% reduction for the younger child of the same parents attending school at the same time. There are further reductions by arrangement for the third and subsequent children. A deposit of £500 for day students is payable on commencement of study. You may withdraw a student at any time provided that you give a full term's notice in writing, submitted before the first day of the final term. A full term's fees are due if the student is removed without such notice.
