**Please be aware that Chase Academy fees are ALL INCLUSIVE.** The fee includes lunches, stationery, textbooks, and even the programme of trips during the school day. The only essential additional costs are fees for external examinations in the senior school. Each term's fees may be paid by the four equal monthly instalments shown above. For day students there is a 20% reduction for the younger child of the same parents attending school at the same time. There are further reductions by arrangement for the third and subsequent children. A deposit of £500 for day students is payable on commencement of study. You may withdraw a student at any time provided that you give a full term's notice in writing, submitted before the first day of the final term. A full term's fees are due if the student is removed without such notice.

One full half term's notice in writing is required if lessons are to be discontinued; otherwise half a term's fees are payable in lieu of notice. No refund is available for lessons missed through a student's absence whatever the reason although alternative arrangements will be made to cover lessons clashing with official school functions.

For boarding students a registration fee of £100 and a deposit of £1500 are required. The full boarding fees include stationery, textbooks, all normal teaching costs, laundry and all meals. Guardianship Service and half term stay are available at additional cost. External examination fees are billed separately. You may withdraw a student at any time provided that you give a full term's notice in writing, submitted before the first day of the final term. You will pay a full term's fees if the student is removed without notice.

**Termly fees are due by the first day of term.**

**Late fees attract interest at the rate of 1.5% per month.**

Deposits are refunded 30 days after the end of the term in which the student leaves, provided sufficient notice has been given.

## **International Boarding Fees September 2008 – August 2009**

Chase Academy, and its associated International Study Centre, offer programmes of study leading to GCSE and AS/A Level qualifications, providing an excellent foundation for University entrance. The programmes are supported by intensive EFL courses, using qualified and experienced teachers. Classes are small – an average of 8 students per class.

The curriculum includes Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Accounting, Business Studies, IT, Art, Music, Humanities, PE, DT, and EFL leading to the Cambridge KET, PET and IELTS examinations.

When students on the International Study Centre programme reach a proficient standard in English Language, they may apply for admission into the main school at Chase Academy and follow a normal English school curriculum.

**For boarding students a registration fee of £100 and a deposit of a full terms' fees are payable on acceptance. The full boarding fees include stationery, textbooks, all normal teaching costs, laundry and all meals. The only extra costs are school uniform, (students following A Level course do not require uniform) and external examination fees. Chase Academy offers a full Guardianship service at a competitive rate.**

**You may withdraw a student at any time provided that you give a full term's notice in writing, submitted before the first day of the final term. You will pay a full term's fees if the student is removed without notice. Deposits are refunded 30 days after the end of the final term. Late fees attract interest at the rate of 1.5% per month.**
